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Drop Off, Pick Up, and Bus Rider:

<u>Drop Off</u>: Please have the student at George Ranch High School (8181 FM 762 Road, Richmond, TX 77469) between 7:45AM – 8:15 AM. Students must enter at the front of the school where a FBRC staff will meet them. Please look for FBRC staff with a Summer Explosion T-shirt or signage.

<u>Pick Up</u>: Please pick up your child at the front of George Ranch High School between 3:15-3:30PM.

<u>Bus Riders</u>: Students will be able to ride LCISD buses that pick up and drop off at your closest elementary school. Schedule is typically not available until the school year ends. Check <u>www.lcisd.org</u> and search for summer transportation schedule.

Dress Code:

Please use good judgment and wear shorts that are appropriate. Summer Explosion T-shirts will be provided and must be worn each day of camp. Please have your student follow their school dress code.

Behavior:
